Q: Is the author available to speak at conferences, employee affinity groups, professional associations events in person and remotely via video conferencing?

Q: I'm a teacher. Can I buy at a discount for my classroom?

A: Yes, when the book was released in July, it climbed three different Amazon Bestseller category lists: to #11 on the Children's Hispanic & Latino books, #20 on the Children's Military Fiction list and also made it onto the Children's "Things That Go" bestseller list. In addition, it debuted on the Amazon #1 spot in both "Hot New Releases" list for Children's Hispanic & Latino books AND Children's Military Fiction categories.

Q: I'm a librarian. Who is your distributor to the school and library market?

A: Hardcover and paperback formats are available through Follett, Brodart, Mackin, Baker and Taylor and Ingram. You can also buy both books, both formats from BookShop.org and Amazon.com.

Q: Where can I find reviews for your books?

A: On the Reviews/Endorsements tab at www.captainmama.com, you'll find reviews from *School Library Journal*, journalists, teachers, parents, a review by the ALA-affiliated group of librarians called REFORMA. You'll see several in Spanish too! You'll also find there many endorsements received before we went to print.

Q: I'm a book store owner. Does Ingram list this title?

A: Yes, wholesaler Ingram can order the book for your store.

Q: Is this book returnable?

A: Because we are a small publishing firm and not staffed to handle returns, we cannot accept returns. If for some reason you find you don't want the book, please donate it to a classroom or library near your home.
